As an attached office under the Department of Agricultural Research and Education, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, ASRB recruits and assesses personnel for the Indian Council of Agricultural Research. Equipped with interview rooms, meeting spaces, examination halls, and a data center, "ChayanBhavan" streamlines its operations.



During the program, the Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare released the ASRB Annual Report. Shri Munda expressed his delight at the inauguration stating that "CHAYAN BHAVAN" will improve ASRB's selection, examination, and related activities. He dedicated the buildings to the nation.
